

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM GUIDELINES

Eligibility

1. Applicant must be a candidate for graduation from high school in the jurisdiction of City of Salem and Roanoke County School systems.
2. Applicant must have a 2.5 GPA average and complete the necessary forms furnished by the scholarship committee. Forms will be complete on each applicant by a guidance counselor and/or principal. Incomplete information/applications are not accepted.
3. The scholarship may be used for tuition to any accredited two-year college, business school, trade or technical school, tools, equipment, licensure, or certification approved by the scholarship committee.
4. Applicant must exhibit citizenship, ambition, and good work ethics.

Financial Consideration

1. The Scholarship will be in the form of a grant.
2. Recipient may accept other scholarships or financial aid.
3. Financial need is a consideration.

Procedures for Seeking Recipients

1. Notice of availability of and regulations governing this scholarship will be sent to the guidance department of high schools in Roanoke County and Salem City.
2. **All applications must be returned to the Chamber office no later than Friday, April 28, 2023, at 5:00PM. No applications will be received after this date/time.** Screening will be done as much as possible from application forms, but the committee reserves the privilege of requesting a personal interview.
3. Recipient will be awarded a scholarship of up to \$1,000.

Scholarship recipients will be recognized at our Showcase on May 5th, 2023 at Salem Red Sox Stadium at 6 p.m. A celebratory dinner will be served
